Baltimore Housing Releases 28 Properties for Rehab in Park Heights

Baltimore Housing is pleased to announce the release of 28 properties for rehabilitation and affordable homeownership in the Park Heights neighborhood. The release is part of Mayor Sheila Dixon's commitment to implement the Park Heights Master Plan and the first in four years. The release of these properties will help enhance the more stabilized neighborhoods of Park Heights by encouraging new investment on blocks with few vacant homes and high homeownership rates. Additional offerings will be available over the next several months and will also include opportunities for infill development.

The 28 properties, arranged in three bundles, are being offered through Baltimore Housing's Rolling Bid Program. Qualified developers should submit proposals by November 2nd. Rolling Bid applications can be picked up at the following location:
